This week our spotlight is on enrichment

An important part of our learning at Ditton Lodge is the enrichment of the children's learning beyond lessons. Year 3 have been embracing these opportunities this week.

We were fortunate to have a parent come and demonstrate their 3D printer to us at the start of the week. It was fascinating to see the printer in action. We also had a fantastic trip to Wandlebury, deepening our understanding of the Iron Age. We walked around the Iron Age hillfort ditch, discovering what it would be like in Iron Age times. We saw how they winnowed the wheat, ground the flour and then we cooked our own bread over a fire. We wove miniature willow walls, learning how this technique would have been used on the roundhouses. Finally, we had a go at firing slingshots, like they would have used to defend the fort.
