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
This week our class spotlight is on Year One

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This week our subject spotlight is English

We have been very busy with our learning in English following the half term. In Structured Storytime EYFS have been learning through the books 'The Dark' by Lemony Snicket and 'Stand up to Racism' by Pragya Agarwal. Year One have been immersing themselves in the book 'There's an Orangutan in my Bedroom' by James Sellick and have been linking this into their writing by writing letters to David Attenborough regarding the rainforest. Year 2 have been comparing texts and exploring language in Aesop's Fables and have been retelling the narrative of the Three Little Pigs using the 3rd Person. Year 3 have been reading the book 'The Magician's Nephew' by C.S. Lewis and have been using their history topic of The Romans to write dialogue through narrative. Year 4 have been reading 'The Wind in the Willows' by Kenneth Grahame and have been writing News Reports on Anglo Saxon Treasure. Year 5 have been reading whether homework should be compulsory or not! Year 6 have been reading the book 'Dare to be You' by Matthew Syed and have been writing some amazing adventure narratives.
