




The maypole dancing this week has been a great activity to end this half-term with. The children have enjoyed working as a team to achieve success with the dances.

### This week our class spotlight is on Year 5

This week, in Year 5, we have been adding and subtracting decimals in Maths, in writing we have been working on including dialogue in a narrative, we have based our stories on the Mayan myth of Creation, this is linked to our History topic, which is the Maya. We have been excited to discovere all the inventions that originated from the Mayan civilisation - calendars and using a place holder zero in maths - More importantly, they discovered Chocolate! We have enjoyed creating different effects with watercolours in Art, we have added different substances to the paint to observe how the watercolour paint reacts. Buddhism is out topic in RE and this week we learnt about meditation and how to focus the mind, using this skill we all grew mandalas. In science we have brought all our learning about Earth and Space together to showcase what we have learnt.
