




A message from Mrs Tweed

This week our class spotlight is on EYFS

We have had a fantastic week in early years learning all about Halloween! Our story has been 'Paddington's Trick or Treat'. Like Paddington, we have made and decorated our own squashed fly biscuits. We have also made and labeled witch's hats, explored potion making with playdough and different coloured water and made dotty pumpkin pictures! We enjoyed a Halloween themed forest school session where we made decorations. In maths we have been learning about shapes with 4 sides. We have also explored shape names and vertices. Early years have had a super first half-term at school. We are incredibly proud of each and every child!





This week our subject spotlight is Maths

There are lots of pupils this week across the school, who have been very proud of their maths work. Pupils in EYFS have been exploring shapes this week with 4 sides. Year 1 pupils have been busy learning about fact families using part whole models. In Year 2, the pupils have been using dienes to help support their understanding of adding tens. Both Year 3 and year 4 pupils have really worked hard this week to use a range of different strategies to add and subtract. Pupils then had to focus on the most efficient strategy to help them solve their equation. Year 5 pupils have been building on their knowledge of factors and multiples to solve a range of reasoning problems. Lastly, Year 6 pupils have learnt about the order of operations this week and which ones take priority in a calculation and why,


