Mrs Moore's Memorable Moment

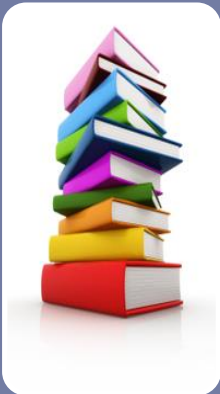

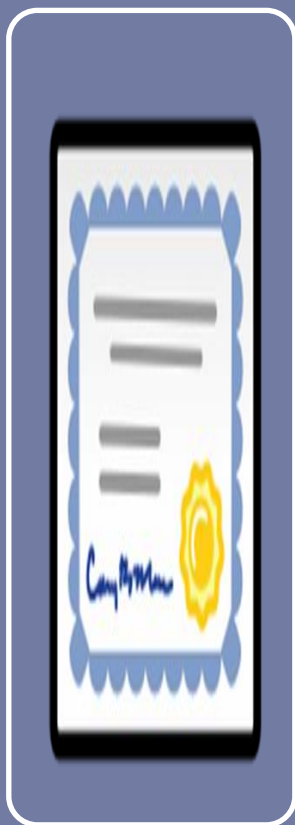
Thank you for all your support to us during this half term. Have a wonderful week and I look forward to seeing you on the 24th.
